2. The syllabus prepared by the department was approved with the following changes:

A. In the Second semester Paper I: CC 201 Introduction to Literary Criticism was replaced with Paper I: CC 201 Indian Literary Theories.

- 6. Kşemendra: Aucityavicāracarcā (1-16)

B. In the third semester the nomenclature of the paper: CC 301, Humanistic Criticism was changed as Literary Criticism

C. In the fourth Semester in the paper II: CC 402, Post Second World War English Literature was replaced with India's Knowledge Texts.

. In this paper new text of Adi Shankaracharya's Vivekacudamani was also introduced in place of Bharatmuni's Natyashastra.
