Minutes of the Board of Studies meeting of the Department of Tourism Management held on 24/05/2022 at University of Patanjali, Haridwar

A meeting of BOS of Department of Tourism Management was held on 24/05/2022 to design & implement the MTTM/MA Tourism curriculum on CBCS pattern.

The meeting was chaired by Dr. Mahavir Agarwal, Pro-Vice Chancellor, University of Patanjali, Haridwar and with honourable presence of Dr. Sadhvi Dev Priya, Dean Humanities & Ancient Studies and Dr. V.K. Katiyar, Dean Academics & Research.

External experts were Dr. Umakant Indolia, DSVV Haridwar, Dr. Saras Verma, Quantum University, Roorkee. Internal Expert was Dr. Aditya Bhargava, UOP. Other members from UOP were Dr. Sanjay Singh, Dr. Abhishek Bhardwaj and Dr. Laxmi Shankar Rath.

Due to some reasons Dr. Sadhvi Dev Priya Ji, Dean Humanities & Ancient Studies and Dr. V.K. Katiyar, Dean Academics & Research were not able to attend the BOS.

In above regard, the following minutes were placed on record:

- A copy of course structure was circulated among the present members to intake the valuable and necessary suggestions to formulate the course as per the guidelines of UGC in terms of CBCS.
- 2. By referring the course structure and syllabus, external experts recommended to include a minor field visit in each semester, through any of the core paper.
- 3. Paper MTTM-CT 301 Research Methodology, shall be interchanged with MTTM-CT 401, Hotel & Resort Management.
- 4. MTTM-SEC 407, shall include only "Basic Sanskrit" instead of Sanskrit & Hindi".
- 5. All the presented members, subject experts appreciated the designed structure of the course that include major core papers of Tourism, Hotel Management, Management subject: Marketing, Human Resource Management, Financial Management, Subject of Yoga as GE, Basic computers, English & Sanskrit and also Music & Sports through Non-CGPA.
