

About the Department

ith the blessings of supreme father and the Gurus, the department of Philosophy was established under the University of Patanjali in the year 2016. The scripture through which the real form of nature, soul and the divine or simlply say that the true form of the soul, the divine and the world is shown is called philosophy or the scripture in which the true form of the above mentioned three elements is known is called philosophy or the state of mind and consciousness in which the elemental perception is eternal with every soul is called darshana. Body, Senses, Mind, Intelligence and various effects of nature as mentioned in philosophical texts are means to achieve happiness. By using them properly, a person becomes free from triple sorrows for ever and ever, and by misusing them, he is filled with sorrows for eternity. "vitarkabādhanepratipakṣabhāvanam" It happens in the 33rd sutra of the second pada of Yoga-Darshana where it has been said that when malevolence starts obstructing, we should take shelter of opposition feeling (pratipakṣabhāvanam). What is pratipakṣabhāvanam? Answering this in the 34^{th} sutra it's said 'duḥkhamajñānañcānantaṃphalameṣāmitipratipakṣabhāvanam'. In other words, when we do not perceive the real nature of things and people, we start misusing them due to lust-anger-greed-attachment-ego and its result is no less than a curse. In Indian philosophy, six Vedic philosophies and three (Charvak, Arhak and Buddhist philosophy) are considered non-Vedic philosophies. There is a couple of two-two for the completeness of subject in six Vedic philosophies like Nyaya-Vaisheshika, Yoga-Sankhya and PurvaMimamsa-Uttara Mimamsa or Vedanta. Nyaya-Vaisheshika is called Arambhavada-Asatkaryavada or expressionism and Sankhya-Yoga is called Consequentialism or SatkaryakaryakaranaOriginism. In the order of reading, first of all PurvaMimamsa, in which religious acts like Yajna-Yaga etc. are important is studied. Secondly Vaisheshika, which explains the base or basic dharma of those religious acts is understood. What is Dharma? – "yato'bhyudayaniḥśreyasasiddhiḥsadharmaḥ" meaning that which leads to the achievement of Abhyudaya and Nishreyasa in life is Dharma. On the third number, Nyaya darshana examines the authenticity of that Dharma on the basis of evidence. On the fourth number, to achieve the subtlety of that Dharma – fulfilling salvation through the four pillars Heya, Heya-hetu, Hana and Hanopaya and achievement of various siddhis and lastly Kaivalya which is the subject of Yogadarshana is studied. Fifthly from Sankhya, the scholar learns the extreme absents of triple sorrows and the description of Animadi siddhis. Finally, in Vedanta philosophy or Brahmasutra, the process of completion of the soul by attaining ultimate equality with Brahma should be known. This is the fundamental and ultimate goal of every human being. In this way, in any field of life, no matter what kind of work a person does, by studying philosophy and doing practical exercises, quality of that work becomes very Satvik and pleasant. Karma-phala system as described in the scriptures, nature of Apavarga, form of bondage, nature of soul, power of soul, Varnashrama Dharma, practical and spiritual side of Ashtanga-Yoga, fruits of Ashtanga-Yoga, what kind of feelings and thoughts should a man have and what thoughts and emotions should be avoided, the power that is running this eternal universe in such a well manner, what is its form and how to worship it etc. are some of the main subjects, with the knowledge of which peace and goodwill can be established in the society, nation and the entire world. 
