

DIFFERENTLY ABLED (DIVYANGJAN) FRIENDLINESS RESOURCES

University of Patanjali gives special attention to the needs and aspirations of the differently-abled (Divyang) students with a focus on their complete integration into functioning and output of the University. Several physical infrastructures as well as friendly environments' has been created for their efficient participation in learning and pan-academic activities.

Following provisions are being made for Divyangjans':

- **Ramps:** University buildings are designed with provisions' of ramps' and hassle free pathways for the easy and dignified movement of divyang students across all of the campus including hostels, mess, academic complexes', sports ground and premises including faculty residences and library etc. To ensure safety during movement all stairways, steps and ramps have railings.
- **Toilets:** There are separate toilets in all buildings' and surrounding premise, designed as disabled friendly in order to cater need of the Divyangs. They have broad door and also have grab bars.
- **Lift:** To ensure hassle free movement across multi-storey buildings', fully equipped lifts are available across all of the campus buildings. A special team is dedicated for operation and maintenance and to ensure safety for all elevators. The number and location of elevators are fixed based upon footfall.
- **Wheelchairs:** Wheelchairs availability is ensured in medical rooms as well as where it is required to cater need in emergency situations'. Corridors are broad *i.e.*, wheelchair enabled. Door width is suitable for wheelchair users in toilets and classrooms.
